Instruction:


- 1. Trace your hand using your pencil or your pen into the paper.
- 2. Write this sentence above your traced hand "My family is special because".
- 3. Write five (5) things you like about your family using the five (5) fingers you traced.
- 4. You may color your traced hand using your crayons. Enjoy the activity.



II. HEAD

The family is the basic unit of our society. Our families started with our parents. They commit to each other that their love will be for eternity. This love bears fruit into a wonderful gift and that is us/you, their children. We are a perfect gift by God to our parents. The moment that our parents know that they will receive a gift their happiness and excitement cannot be contained. They are so happy to have us in their lives.

We are grateful to God for the gift of life. Thus, we need to share this beautiful life with our families by being good to them always. How can I be a good son/daughter to my parents? It is by imitating Jesus.



III. HEART

How can I imitate Jesus as a role model to my family?

1. Be Respectful to your Parents

Respect is important in our relationship with our families. Without respect for each other, our families will be in disorder. How can we respect our parents? By following what they say, by doing my assignment and studying my subjects before playing, by always saying "Po and Opo", and most especially by grabbing their hands and make the "mano po".

2. Be a Responsible Son/Daughter

Each of us has a responsibility in our families. You may be the eldest, the youngest, or the only child, but we are all given responsibilities inside our families. How can we be a responsible son's and daughter; By arranging our toys after we play, by cleaning our own rooms, by throwing our trash properly, and taking care of your younger siblings, etc.

3. Be Loving and Forgiving

In a family, everyone is different, and conflict may arise. There will be times that our parents are not in favor of what we want, but it does not mean that they do not love us. All they want for us is our own good. There will be also times that our siblings will annoy us; by getting our toys, and sometimes they will use our things without our permission, etc. But we need to understand that they are still our family and even though there are times that we get annoyed

by them, we still need to forgive and love them. Say sorry if we are the one that causes the conflict and always forgive if they ask for forgiveness.

Jesus has a family. He grew up having Mama Mary and Papa Joseph as His parents. He obeyed them and loved them the most. Just like Jesus we need to love and respect our parents.

Activity: Family Diorama

Materials:

- Shoe Box
- Coloring Material
- Sticks
- Glue

• Picture of each family member

Instructions:

- Bring a shoe box
- Paint/Color a background on the inside of it
- Make stand up pictures of your house and family
- Glue the pictures in your box



C. Step up (11-12 years old)

Activity: Household

Discussion question:

- What are the things you are thankful about your Family?
- What are the things you are praying for about your Family?

- I will be a good sister/brother to my siblings through sharing and supporting them.


3. I will be an active member of MFC Kids
