"Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light for my path." - Psalm 119:105

L - Let the light of Christ, through your parents' guide you.

A - Allow them to guide you.

Activity: Coloring

B. First Step (5-7 years old) and Foot Step (8-10 years old)

Activity: Lamp Making

Materials:

- Bond Paper
- Scissors
- Pen/Pencil
- Crayons
- Glue

Instructions:

- Draw out the letter L and the lampshade/plug templates.
- Cut them out and trace the letter L on the yellow paper. Trace the lampshade on the white paper.
- Glue the letter L to the middle of a white sheet of construction paper.
 This will serve as the base of the lamp.
- Use the markers and color the lampshade however you would like.
 Glue on top of the letter L. (L represent LOVE)
- With a black marker, draw a cord coming from the base of the lamp.
- Color in the plug template in black and cut out to glue at the end of the cord.
- Done! You have finished creating your letter L lamp craft.

3. I will be an active member of MFC Kids


- I will always attend and participate in all MFC Kids activities.


