Objectives:

At the end of the Kids Assembly, MFC Kids will be able to:

- Appreciate and be grateful for all the blessings they have received throughout the year

- Be good stewards of God's blessings in their lives

I. MOTIVATION

Activity: Count your blessings and be a blessing!

Instructions:

- Ask the kids to close their eyes and start counting to 10. Ask them to think of all the blessings they've received since the start of the year.
- 2. Ask the kids to list down all the blessings and gifts that they remembered! Explain to them that God is giving us countless blessings because He loves us so much and He wants us to be happy all the time.
- 3. Challenge them on what they should be doing, now that they've realized how God is being generous to them.

We can practice this by sharing our food and toys with others. We can also say thank you to our parents more often. Remember that you can be a blessing in your own simple and little ways.


