# I AM GIFTED



## Objectives:

At the end of the Kids Assembly, MFC Kids will be able to:

- Understand that their identity is one of God's gifts to them
- Appreciate that their uniqueness makes them special and gifted
- Value their giftedness and share it to others



## I. MOTIVATION

**Activity:** Identity Circle

**Materials:** Paper, Pencil and Coloring Materials

**Instructions:**

1. Draw a large circle in the middle and make four smaller circles outside the big circle.
2. Draw a picture of yourself in the center circle.
3. Describe yourself by writing different characteristics of yourself in each of the outer circles (example: long/short hair, round/narrow eyes)

*1 John 3:1*

*"See what love the Father has bestowed on us that we may be called the children of God. Yet so we are. The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him."*



## II. HEAD

We are God's greatest creation. He created us unique and special. We have our gifts and He wants us to appreciate our giftedness for us to discover our real identity. God wants us to seek and discover all the things that He has given us and be always reminded that we are His children.



## III. HEART

God wants us to treasure our identity and giftedness. How are we going to take care of our gifts? Gifts are meant to be shared - so for us to take care of our gifts, we need to GIVE!

### **G – Giving of Ourselves to Others**

We can give ourselves to others by loving and respecting our parents, siblings, and friends. We can also give ourselves by helping our parents with the household chores, and sharing the things that we have (ex. toys, food, etc.) with our friends/siblings.

### **I – Imitate Jesus**

We can imitate Jesus by always talking to Him during our prayer time. This can make us like Jesus. Imitating Jesus means doing our best to be like Him. We can also imitate Jesus if we continue to develop our relationship w/ Him.



### **V – Value our Giftedness**

We can value our giftedness by counting our blessings and not comparing ourselves to others. We can also value our giftedness if we continue to strive to be great in using our gifts (talents and skills) and be the best of who we are.

### **E – Encourage Everyone to be Close to Jesus**

Let us continue to encourage our friends and classmates to attend our activities in MFC Kids. Let's encourage them to join and attend our Kids Assemblies, Kids Camp, Kids Day, LTW Kids and the like. When we encourage others to have a personal relationship with Jesus, our gifts will continue to grow!



## IV. HANDS

### A. For Kids at Play (3-4 years old)

**Activity:** Connect the dots

**Materials:**

- Pencil
- Coloring Materials
- Printed copy of Appendix A

### B. First Step (5-7 years old) and Foot Step (8-10 years old)

**Activity:** Self Portrait Activity

**Materials:**

- Bond Paper
- Pencil
- Coloring Materials
- Ruler
- Glue (optional)
- Art Paper (optional)

## Instructions:

1. We will create a road map of ourselves on a paper
2. Draw yourself on a paper the same size as the picture below
3. Draw puzzle pieces around your self-portrait picture and decorate each piece.
4. You will put or draw on each puzzle piece your identity like Favorite Food, Talent, Country Flag, Hobbies, Favorite Animal, Name of your Family member, name of your friends, etc (Please see the sample picture below).
5. You can put some designs, colors and decorations on your Self Portrait Activity



### C. Step up (11-12 years old)

**Activity:** Household

**Discussion question:**

1. Who gave your name? Do you like/dislike your name?
2. Being who you are now, what are the blessing/gifts that you received recently?
3. What are some concrete ways to share your blessing/gifts to others?



### IV. TAKE AWAY

A gift is made to value and use it properly. That's why we as a gift, needs to take good care of ourselves, and we are to value our giftedness by using and sharing it to others.

- I will be a good sister/brother to my siblings through sharing and supporting them.

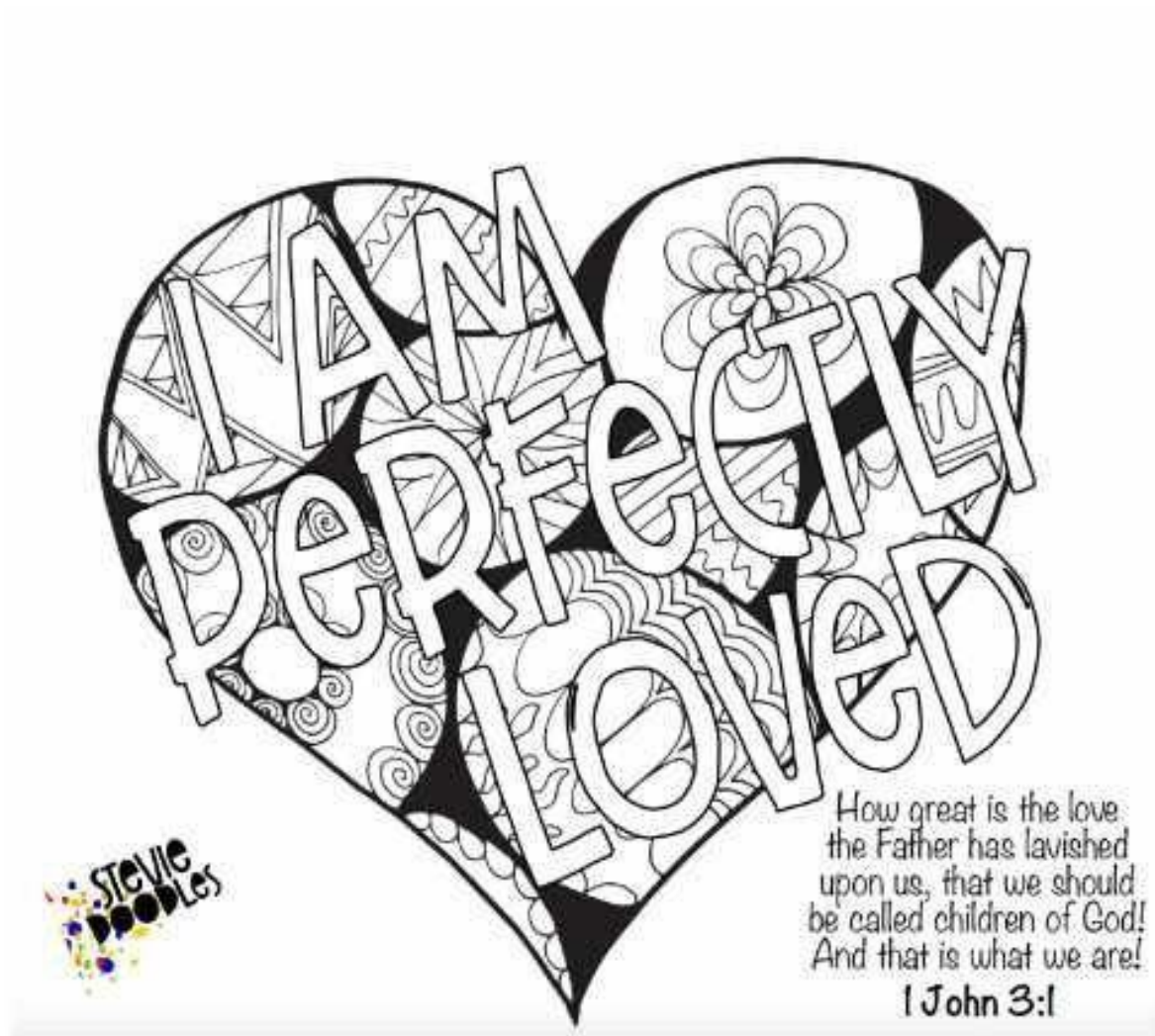
### **3. I will be an active member of MFC Kids**

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Thank you for letting your child/children participate in our Kids Assembly this month. We honor your patience and love for your kid/s that you allowed them to hear God's messages for them. We talked about their giftedness and identity as God's children. We also discussed the importance of their gifts and how they can share it to others.

Since you, the parents are the primary educators & evangelizes of your children, we invite and encourage you to do the following activities to make you and your child/children rediscover your giftedness together!

**1. GUESS WHO?! (Game)** - It's time to play! Write the different identity of your family member and allow your kids to identify who that person is. Example: (Tallest – Dad, Long Hair – Mom, No hair – Dad, Curly Hair – Ate/Kuya)

**2. COUNT YOUR BLESSINGS!** We are all blessed! And part of that blessing is our identity. Let's write down on a piece of paper together w/ our kids, all the blessings that we received or have at the moment. Then at the end of the activity, remind them to be grateful for these things and that they too, are God's gifts to your family and to the world!



Let us all pray the prayer that God taught us –

“Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.”
