OBJECTIVES

At the end of the Kids Assembly, MFC Kids will be able to:

- Realize that we are very much blessed by God
- Appreciate the joy of giving and spreading love this Christmas
- Learn that Christmas is the season of sharing love to the world

MOTIVATION

Activity: Count Your Blessings! (Writing Activity)



Materials:

- Colored Paper or Different colors of Post-it
- Markers
- Masking Tape (if necessary)

Instructions:

- 1. Each kid will be given 6 pcs of ¼ size of colored paper or post-it.
- 2. Instruct the participants to write 3 big blessings and 3 small blessings and post it on the wall.



EXPANDED OUTLINE I. HEAD

What are the things that make you happy and thankful? Can you think of special moments from this year? I hope you wrote them down. As we finish this year 2023, let's all shout together - 'THANK YOU, JESUS, BECAUSE I FEEL LOVED BY YOU!' As MFC Kids, many of us had different experiences this year—some good and maybe some tough ones. 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II. HEART

"Do not forget to do good and to help one another, because these are the sacrifices that please God." - Hebrews 13:16

This time of the year, as Christmas is getting closer, feels really special! It's all about a happy feeling that comes from sharing, caring, and making others happy during this festive season. When we give to others, like giving nice gifts, being kind, or spending time with them, we make a warm and joyful atmosphere that is more than just about gifts you can touch.

In a world where sometimes people are mostly thinking about getting things, the joy of giving reminds us that being kind and helping others feels really special. Activity: Christmas Coloring Page (see Appendix A)

Materials: Coloring Materials, Coloring Page

Instructions:

- Get your crayons or any of your coloring materials and start to put colors into the drawing page.
- Note to the facilitator: After doing the activity, before the assembly ends, call some representatives and let the kids share their work to the group.

B. First Steps (5-7 years old), Footsteps (8-10 years old) and Step Up (10-12 years old)

Activity: Gratitude Tree (see Appendix B)

Materials:

- Colored Papers / Construction Papers
- Bond Paper
- Pencil / Ballpen / Marker
- Scissor
- Glue

Instructions:

- 1. Make a gratitude tree
- 2. Trace and cut different kinds and shapes of leaves and
- 3. Write what you're grateful for on each leaf
- 4. Trace and cut a tree trunk as well
- 5. Hang the leaves up by pasting them unto the branches (upper part) of the tree
- 6. Create as many leaves / blessings as you can!
- 7. Write your name and make your craft as colorful as you can

We are blessed in many ways because of the many important persons in our lives - ultimately because of God! May we always be grateful and contented with all these blessings and may we always recognize God's goodness in our lives.
