TITLE:

OBJECTIVES:

At the end of the Kids Assembly, MFC Kids will be able to:

1. Acknowledge that life is a gift from God
2. Appreciate our families as part of God's gift of life for us
3. Be a role model to our families and be a kid prolife warrior

MOTIVATION:

Activity: Paint Me a Picture

Instructions:

- Divide the kids into groups, depending on the number of participants.
- Each group would copy the pose of the projected image. Images will be about families.

Ex.

- Family eating together
- Family attending mass
- Family watching a movie
- Parents reading a bed time story to their kids
- Family praying the rosary
- Older siblings helping take care of a younger sibling
- Grandchildren taking care of their grandparents
- Family welcoming a new baby
- Family walking on a park hand in hand
- Children helping their parents with the household chores

- A set of judges would determine who wins each round.

EXPANDED OUTLINE



I. HEAD

Life is a gift from God because He made each one of us with love. He made each of us special and gave us the chance to smile, play, learn, and love. God has given us many wonderful gifts in life — the sunshine, the stars, our friends, and our favorite things to do. But one of the greatest gifts He gives us is our family.



Our families are one of the most special gifts God has given us. They love us, care for us, and help us grow into the people God wants us to be. Our life is God's perfect gift, and He chose our parents to bring us into the world. Just imagine how excited and happy they were when they found out they were going to have us! Because life is such a beautiful gift, we should always be thankful to God. And the best way to show that thanks is by protecting that gift of life and the family by being a pro life warrior.




II. HEART

When Jesus was a child, He showed us what it means to be a loving and respectful member of a family. He is the perfect example of a Pro-Life Warrior, honoring life and those around Him. Being a Pro-Life Warrior means standing up for the value of every human life, especially babies who are still growing in their mother's womb and cannot speak for themselves. Even as young as we are, we can be part of this important mission by following His example and be role models in our families by doing these three things:

- 1. Respect and Listen to Your Parents** - Jesus listened to Mary and Joseph and treated them with respect. In the same way, we can show love by listening to our parents and following their guidance. Respecting our parents means being patient, even when things don't go our way, and speaking and acting kindly toward our mom, dad, brothers, and sisters.
- 2. Help and Serve Others** - Jesus grew up helping His family and neighbors. We can be like Jesus by helping out at home and in our community. Doing chores without being asked, sharing our toys or food with our siblings, and being thoughtful about what others need are simple but meaningful ways to serve. When we help others, we make their lives easier and happier, and we also grow kinder and more loving in our own hearts. Even small acts of help, when done with love, can make a big difference—just as Jesus showed us.
- 3. Be a Kid Pro Life Warrior** - Jesus loves children and protects them. Even though we are young, we can still be Pro-Life Warriors by helping protect unborn babies. We can pray for moms and their babies, asking God to keep them safe and to help moms choose life. We can also tell others that all babies are special and should be loved, even before they are born. By being kind and loving to everyone around us, we show that every life is a gift and truly important.

Materials



- Bond Paper or Construction paper
- Markers and coloring materials
- Paint or Ink Stamp


Instructions:

1. Start by making a fist and dipping the pinkie side of your hand into the paint. And carefully press it onto the paper. Use this to print the main part of the foot.
2. Add the tiny toe prints by dipping your little finger into the paint and press small dots above the foot shape.
3. On the roots, write the things that connect you to Jesus (e.g., Prayer, Bible, Church, MFC Kids, Worship).
4. Add pro life phrases using paint or markers.

Ex.

- Choose Life
- Life is a Gift
- God loves every Baby
- Every Life is Precious
- Family means Love
- Life is Beautiful
- Yes to Life






TAKE AWAY


